The Board has noted the increasing level of compounding by pharmacists, the types of products being prepared and associated risks The Board has published guidelines including in its Guidelines on dispensing of medicines, a section on compounding otherwise known as extemporaneous dispensing

Compounding Nonsterile Products in Pharmacies Introduction Pharmacists are the only health care providers formally trained in the art and science of compounding medications^{1,2} Therefore pharmacists are expected, by the medical community and the public, to possess the knowledge and skills necessary to compound extemporaneous preparations

Assigning expiry dates to compounded medications

Several sections in the Guidelines provide detailed requirements regarding expiry dates: 8 • When compounding medicines, pharmacists must ensure that there is good clinical and pharmaceutical evidence to support the quality, stability (including appropriate expiry periods), safety, efficacy and rationality of any extemporaneous formulation
